The above-named individual was arrested Wednesday, September 23, 2020 on one (1) count of Aggravated Sexual Assault [victim under thirteen (13) years old], one (1) count of Sexual Assault [victim under (13) years old and defendant more than four (4) years older], and one (1) count of Sexual Assault [victim at least thirteen (13) but less than sixteen (16)]. Aggravated Sexual Assault is a First Degree Crime punishable by up to twenty (20) years New Jersey State Prison. Sexual Assault is a Second Degree Crime punishable by up to ten (10) years New Jersey State Prison.


The complaint alleges that the defendant committed multiple acts of sexual penetration, specifically oral, and anal penetration, as well as sexual contact upon a child under thirteen (13) years of age and continued the acts after the child was at least thirteen (13) but not more than sixteen (16) years of age. The acts occurred between 1995-1998 in the Town of Phillipsburg. The child in question was known to the defendant.

The defendant's first appearance took place Tuesday, October 6, 2020, before the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C. The State filed a Motion to Detain the defendant pretrial. That hearing took place on Thursday, October 8, 2020. At the conclusion of the Pretrial Detention Hearing, the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C. denied the State's application and released the defendant on pretrial monitoring with conditions.

The Warren County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit along with the Phillipsburg Police Department conducted the investigation.

Please be advised that the charges are merely accusations and that the defendant is presumed innocent until or unless proven guilty.
