On October 1, 2020, following a month long investigation into the distribution of cocaine in the Hackettstown Area, the Hackettstown Police Department, Independence Township Police Department, Washington Township Police Department, Phillipsburg Police Department and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Unit executed a search warrant at 48 Petersburg Road Hackettstown, New Jersey resulting in the arrest of four individuals, confiscation of CDS (cocaine), drug paraphernalia and hypodermic syringes.

Shane Cole was charged with:

- 1. Four (4) counts of Distribution of CDS (cocaine), a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(3);
- 2. One (1) count of Drug Paraphernalia, a disorderly persons offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C: 36-2;
- 3. One (1) count of Possession of Hypodermic Syringes, a disorderly persons offense, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:36-6.

Scott Kramer was charged with:

1. One (1) count of Possession of CDS (cocaine), a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35:10a(1).

Celia Ortiz was charged with:

1. One (1) count of Possession of CDS (cocaine), a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35:10a(1).

Raymond Cole Jr. was charged with:

1. One (1) count of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, a disorderly persons offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:36-2.

Each third degree offense carries a maximum of five years New Jersey State Prison. Disorderly person's offenses carry a maximum of 180 days Warren County Correctional Center.

The Defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
