**CHARGED: BRIAN SLACK JR.**

After a month long investigation into the distribution of CDS in the Phillipsburg Area, conducted by the Phillipsburg Police Department, Warren County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Unit, Hackettstown Police Department, New Jersey State Police, Washington Township Police Department and with the assistance of the Pohatcong Township Police Department and the Warren County Tactical Response Team, a narcotics search warrant was executed on October 16, 2020 at 268 Chambers Street Apt. 1 Phillipsburg, New Jersey resulting in the arrest of Brian Slack Jr., and the confiscation of CDS (Cocaine, Methamphetamine, MDMA Pills, Marijuana), Drug Paraphernalia and US Currency.

Brian Slack Jr. was charged with:

1. Three (3) counts of Possession of CDS (Cocaine, Methamphetamine, MDMA Pills), a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:25-10A(1);
2. One (1) count of Possession of Marijuana, a fourth degree offense in violation to 2C:35-10A(4);
3. One (1) count of Possession with the intent to Distribute CDS within 500 ft. of a Public Park, a third degree offense in violation to 2C:35-7.1A;
4. One (1) count of Possession with the intent to Distribute CDS, a third degree offense in violation to 2C:35-5B(3);
5. One (1) count of Drug Paraphernalia, a disorderly person's offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C: 36-2.

Each third degree offense carries a maximum of five years New Jersey State Prison. Fourth Degree offenses carry a maximum of eighteen (18) months New Jersey State Prison. Disorderly person's offenses carry a maximum of 180 days Warren County Correctional Center.

The Defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
