CONVICTED: Herman Quintana

Phillipsburg, New Jersey 08865

On August 11, 2020, the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C. sentenced Herman Quintana on the following counts:

- Three counts of Sexual Assault [victim under thirteen (13) years old], second degree; and
- Three counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (sexual conduct), second degree.

Specifically, the Honorable H. Matthew Curry sentenced Defendant Quintana to eight (8) years New Jersey State Prison pursuant to the No Early Release Act, on each Sexual Assault count. In addition, Judge Curry sentenced Defendant Quintana to five (5) years New Jersey State Prison, on each Endangering the Welfare of a Child count. All sentences are to run concurrent. Defendant Quintana is subject to Megan's Law Registration and Parole Supervision for Life. Judge Curry also ordered that the Defendant forfeit his New Jersey Licensed Practical Nurse (L.P.N.) License.


By way of background, on December 12, 2019, a Warren County jury found Herman Quintana guilty on all counts of a six (6) count Indictment. The trial occurred in Superior Court before the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C. The State was represented by Assistant Prosecutor Jessica L. Cardone. The defendant was represented by Steven Lember, Esquire.

Specifically, Defendant Quintana was convicted of the following:

- Three counts of Sexual Assault [victim under thirteen (13) years old], second degree; and

- Three counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (sexual conduct), second degree.

These convictions stem from the defendant committing multiple acts of sexual contact, upon two child victims. The acts occurred between the dates of March 2015 to September 2016, when the children were six (6) and ten (10) years old. In addition, the jury found the defendant guilty of Endangering the Welfare of the Child stemming from that sexual conduct. The children victims were known to the defendant. These crimes occurred in Phillipsburg, Warren County.
