## PRESS RELEASE

### **CHARGED:**

**Jennifer Crane**  
**2511 Route 57**  
**Stewartsville, N.J.**

On November 14, Phillipsburg Police performed a traffic stop on Jennifer Crane, 37, of Stewartsville, for having tinted windows and failing to signal while turning. Shortly after, it was determined that Ms. Crane was driving while her license had been suspended. During her subsequent arrest, officers discovered cocaine and methamphetamine on Ms. Crane's person. As a result, a search warrant was sought, obtained, and executed on the vehicle Ms. Crane was driving. This search yielded over one ounce of suspected methamphetamine, nearly a half ounce of suspected cocaine, 132 pills believed to be Fentanyl, and 43 pills of suspected Ecstasy. In addition, \$3,084 in U.S. currency was also seized.


Ms. Crane was charged with the following offenses:

- I. Possession with Intent to Distribute over one-half ounce of Methamphetamine, Second Degree, 2C:35-5(b)
- II. Possession with Intent to Distribute less than one-half ounce of Cocaine, Third Degree, 2C:35-5(b)
- III. Possession with Intent to Distribute less than one-half ounce of Fentanyl, Third Degree, 2C:35-5(b)
- IV. Possession with Intent to Distribute less than one-half ounce of Ecstasy, Second Degree, 2C:35-5(b)

Second Degree offenses carry a maximum potential sentence of 10 years in New Jersey State Prison.  
Third Degree offenses carry a maximum potential sentence of 5 years in New Jersey State Prison.

Please be advised that the charges are merely accusations and that the defendant is presumed innocent until and if proven guilty at trial beyond a reasonable doubt.
