• Third Degree Endangering the Welfare of Children for Knowingly Possessing Images that Depict Child Sexual Abuse

The aforementioned individual, Kyle F. Fasulka, was charged with one count of endangering the welfare of children, contrary to N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4b(5)(b)(iii), for knowingly possessing images that depict child sexual abuse. The investigation into this matter began after law enforcement received a report that several images portraying children being sexually exploited and abused were saved to an account on Snapchat. Through various investigative means, detectives from the Warren County Prosecutor's Office were able to trace the source of the uploads. A search warrant was then executed upon the suspect's home and several electronic devices were seized. Soon after, the suspect was criminally charged.

If convicted, the accused may be sentenced to 5 years in State Prison. Please note, the instant charge is merely an accusation and all defendants are presumed innocent unless their guilt is proven beyond a reasonable doubt.

The investigation is continuing, and no further information is available at this time. Anyone who believes they may have information relevant to this investigation is encouraged to contact the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Cyber Crimes Unit (908)475-6275.
