On August 16, 2019, a Warren County jury found Justin D. Williams guilty of seven (7) charges of a fourteen (14) count Indictment. The trial occurred in Superior Court before the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C. The defendant was represented by Jason Seidman, Esquire and Brett Rosen, Esquire of The Law Offices of Johnathan F. Marshall. Assistant Prosecutor Jessica L. Cardone represented the State.

Specifically, Defendant Williams was convicted of the following:

- Two counts of Aggravated Sexual Assault [victim under thirteen (13) years old], first degree;
- Two counts of Sexual Assault [victim under thirteen (13) years old], second degree; and
- Three counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (sexual conduct), second degree.


These convictions stem from the defendant committing multiple acts of sexual contact and sexual penetration, specifically digital penetration, upon the child victim. The acts occurred between the dates of June 2008 until June 2013, beginning when the child was six (6) years old until the child turned eleven (11) years old. In addition, the jury found the defendant guilty of Endangering the Welfare of the Child stemming from sexual conduct between the diverse dates of June 2013 to June 2015. The child victim was known to the defendant. These crimes occurred in Washington Boro, Oxford, and Washington Township, Warren County, respectively.

Upon his conviction, the Court granted the State's request to revoke bail and remand the defendant to the Warren County jail pending his sentence.

Defendant Williams is scheduled for a Motion to Reinstate Bail on Wednesday, August 21, 2019 at 11:30AM. The defendant will be sentenced at a later date. Defendant Williams is subject to a maximum of twenty (20) years New Jersey State Prison pursuant to the No Early Release Act, on each First Degree count and ten (10) years New Jersey State Prison on each Second Degree count. Defendant Williams will also be subject to Megan's Law Registration and Parole Supervision for Life.
